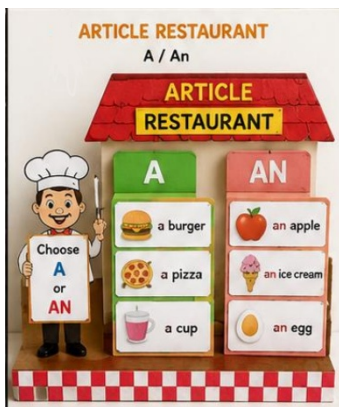
Q1- Read any one story from the following:

## MATHS

### 1. The "Skip-Counting" Caterpillar

Class 1 introduces the foundation of multiplication through skip counting.

The Project: Create a long wall-hanging caterpillar using paper plates or colorful paper circles.

On each segment of the caterpillar, the student writes a number in a sequence (e.g., Skip counting by 2s: 2, 4, 6, 8... or 5s: 5, 10, 15, 20...).

They can make multiple caterpillars for different tables (2, 3, 4, 5 and 10).

Handmade Element: Let them decorate the caterpillar's face with scrap fabric or wool to keep it tactile and fun.

### 2.The "Bird's Eye View"

Sit in your balcony, park, or garden for 10 minutes and observe the surroundings carefully. Create a small table and answer the questions in a scrapbook.
