Pick out ten new words from each story. Make a beautiful 'Pictionary' by writing these words, their meanings and a picture related to the word.

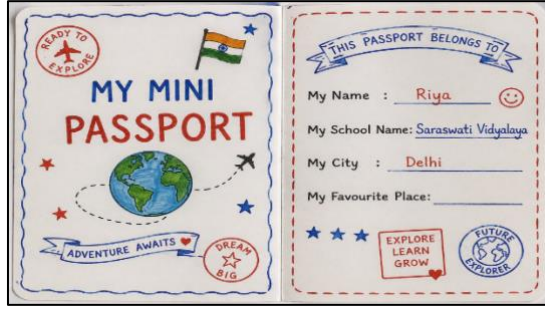
2. My Mini Passport- Make a small colourful passport booklet about yourself. (Roll No. 1 to 20)

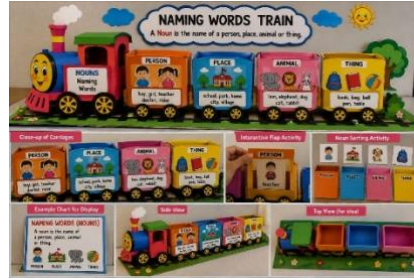
Write all Proper Nouns (eg- Riya, Saraswati Vidyalaya, Delhi, etc.) with a red or blue colour.

## MATHS

### 1. The "My Family" Number Tree

**Goal:** Understanding Place Value.

**Activity:** Draw a large tree in your scrapbook. On the leaves, write the ages of your family members (Mother, Father, Grandparents, etc.).

**Written Task:**

- Arrange the ages in Ascending Order (Smallest to Biggest).
- Write the Number Name for the oldest person's age.
- Break the ages into Tens and Ones. (Example:  $35 = 3 \text{ Tens} + 5 \text{ Ones}$ ).

### 2. Household "Scavenger Hunt" (Roll No. 1 to 20)

Turn the house into a math playground.

**The Task:**

- Find and record items with pictures in a scrapbook that fit specific mathematical criteria:
- Five things that weighs more than 1kg but less than 5kg.
- An object with exactly 4 corners and 4 equal sides.
- Two object that is roughly 15 centimeters long (using a ruler to verify).
- Find the total number of "legs" in the house (chairs + tables + people + pets).

### 3. The "Shape-O-Saur" or "Shape-Bot" (Roll 21 to last Roll No.)

This project helps children identify 2D and 3D shapes in everyday life.

**The Project:** Build a dinosaur or a robot using only recycled materials (empty matchboxes, toilet paper rolls, bottle caps).

- Once the model is built, the student must create a "Shape Audit" chart.
  - How many Cylinders (rolls) were used?
  - How many Cuboids (boxes) were used?
  - How many Circles (bottle caps) were used?
  - Creative Touch: Encourage students to paint it in a vintage or retro color palette (burnt orange, teal, or mustard) for a cool, classic look.
4. Learn and write tables 2 to 10 in your scrapbook.

## EVS

1. Read L15. Plants Around Us, L4. Food, L5. Clothes. Learn and write 10 difficult words in your EVS notebook.
2. **HELPING HAND:** Help your parents in household chores. Click any 10 pictures and paste them in your scrapbook. Explain each picture briefly.
3. Grow a plant. Water it everyday. Click pictures with its growth and paste them in your scrapbook.
4. Make any one item using waste material according to your Roll numbers:
  - 👉 Roll. no. 1–10 – An animal or a bird
  - 👉 Roll no. 11–20 – A wall hanging.
  - 👉 Roll no. 21–30 – A means of transport
  - 👉 Roll no. 31 onwards – scenery

## COMPUTER

Make a poster on A4 / A3 size sheets on any one of the following:

- a) Parts of Computer
- b) Uses of Computer

## ART & CRAFT

- 1) Make a poster “ Eat healthy stay healthy” on A3 size sheet.
- 2) Make two paper CRAFT Origami (ex- fish, dog, tulip, doll etc).

1. Make a colorful collage of popular dishes of India on an outline map of India. Paste or draw famous dishes in the states they belong to, such as Dosa, Dhokla, Idli, Chole Bhatore, Rasgulla, etc.

## SUBJECT INTEGRATED PROJECT: “MY SMART CITY”

Imagine and create your own Smart City Model using waste materials, cardboard, clay, colours, lights, etc.

Based on your model, complete the following activities in a scrapbook.

**1) English (Creative Writing):** Write a short paragraph (5-6 lines) about your Smart City. Include:

- What makes your city smart
- Places in your city, etc.

**2) Mathematics (Measurement & Calculation):** Calculate the total cost of making your Smart City model. Include:

- Cost of colours/chart paper
- Cost of lights or decorations
- Cost of other materials used
- Show the addition properly and write the final total.

**3) EVS (Awareness Activity):** Write 4 ways to keep your city clean.

**Examples**

- Clean parks
- Dustbins everywhere

**4) Art & Craft (Model Making):** Make a colourful Smart City Model showing:

- Roads and traffic signals
- Buildings, parks, and schools
- Dustbins and clean surroundings
- Decorate it creatively using eco-friendly materials.

**5) Hindi (रचनात्मक लेखन):** “मेरा स्मार्ट सिटी” विषय पर 5-6 पंक्तियाँ लिखिए।
